Chicago History Museum and Lunch

ADULTS

After 150 years of celebrating Chicago's remarkable history, the Chicago Historical Society unveiled the new Chicago History Museum. The \$275 million renovation features a variety of long-term and temporary exhibits. Visit the Chicago Crossroads Gallery of America, which highlights a rich collection of artifacts that tells the story of Chicago. You may also explore the Community Gallery where visitors learn about the diverse communities of Chicago, and the new Costume and Textile Gallery featuring clothing and culture from all periods of Chicago and U.S. history. Many artifacts never seen before by the public are accessible in a new installation called Treasures, featuring 22 million artifacts and documents. You will also enjoy the Sangar Robinson Gallery, which displays treasures from the World's Fairs of 1893 and 1933. The trip includes lunch at the museum, transportation and entrance fee. This is a cooperative trip with the Addison Park District.
