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### **Q: Is the Pool on Pacific opening this summer?**

*A: The Pool on Pacific is opening for In-District Residents **ONLY**. Those who live south of Grand Avenue are out-of-district and ineligible. A valid Resident Pass is required for purchasing a Pool Pass or paying daily admission.*

### **Q: What is a Resident Pass?**

*A: A Resident Pass proves in-district residency. You can obtain or renew a Resident Pass at the Community Center, 9560 Franklin Avenue. A driver's license and proof of address is needed.*

### **Q: Will there be a capacity limit at the pool?**

*A: The pool will operate at a capacity limit of 50 patrons or based on IDPH guidelines. A reservation system is being implemented and reservations will be required before arrival.*

### **Q: How long will reservation slots be?**

*A: The pool's hours will be split into time slots of two hours and ten minutes. After each time slot, the pool will close for 45 minutes to ensure staff has enough time to properly sanitize. Patrons must exit the pool in a timely fashion when their slot has ended.*

### **Q: How can reservations be made?**

*A: Reservations can be made by calling the Pool on Pacific at (847) 928-8480. You will need to notify staff if you are a pass holder or plan on paying the daily admission fee.*

### **Q: Are masks required at the pool?**

*A: Masks are required for entering the facility, using the locker rooms and when social distancing is not possible. Masks are not required while in the water or seated in your pod.*

### **Q: How will seating arrangements be made?**

*A: Staff will prepare socially distanced seating pods for up to six people. One chair will be available per person. It is recommended to only sit with members of your own household.*

### **Q: Will any aquatic programs be available this summer?**

*A: Swim Lessons will be offered for both residents and non-residents. Session information and fees can be viewed online. Adult Lap Swim and Bubbles & Babies will be offered before the pool opens. Reservations are required. These offerings are free for pass holders or \$5.00 admission with a Resident Pass.*

### **Q: Will pool rentals be available?**

*A: Private weekend pool rentals on Saturday and Sunday evenings will be available for both residents and non-residents. The maximum amount of patrons is 50. Contact the Park District of Franklin Park at (847) 455-2852 for availability and more information.*
