AN ORDINANCE MAKING A COMBINED ANNUAL BUDGET AND APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FOR THE PARK DISTRICT OF FRANKLIN PARK, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING ON THE 1st DAY OF MAY, 2019, AND ENDING ON THE 30th DAY OF APRIL, 2020.

WHEREAS, the Board of Park Commissioners of the Park District of Franklin Park has caused to be prepared in tentative form a combined annual budget and appropriation ordinance and the Secretary of the Board has made same conveniently available for public inspection for at least thirty (30) days prior to final action thereon; and

A certified copy of this Ordinance shall be filed with the County Clerk of Cook County, Illinois, together with the certificate of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the Park District certifying revenues by source anticipated to be received by the Park District, within thirty (30) days after its passage and approval, as provided by law.
